The facility has an annual production capacity of 4.7 tonnes of gold jewellery and 1.8 lakh carats of diamond jewellery, along with a refining capacity of 78 tonnes. Over 2,750 skilled artisans, drawn from 18 states, work at the unit, with 40% of the workforce locally recruited. Equipped with advanced machinery from the USA, Germany, Italy, and Turkey, and supported by international consultants, the facility is built to cater to global markets.

Inaugurated by the Chief Minister of Telangana, Sri Revanth Reddy, and senior leadership from Malabar Group, this facility will support the brand's retail expansion across India and beyond. With advanced technologies like 3D printing, laser cutting, and CNC machining, the unit is also home to a design studio, R&D center, and in-house skill development programs.
